## Facts I will be learning about:

**Science** – I will be exploring different materials and their features. I will also be investigating plants found on the coast and finding out about land and sea creatures and their habitats.

**History** – I will be investigating what I like about seaside holidays today and I will be taking a look back to why and how seaside holidays became popular in the 19<sup>th</sup> century and how they have changed since.

**Geography** – I will be learning about oceans, seas, continents and countries, finding out about different human and physical features of our seas and coasts. I will also be learning about jobs and resources that are linked to the sea.

**Art** – I will be learning about two textiles techniques, weaving and wax-resist dyeing. I will weave paper and other materials to create under the sea placemats and use my paper weaving skills to create a handmade bag. I will learn about the use of batik in Indonesia before designing and making my own batik coaster.

**DT** – I will learn to work with fabric. I will evaluate a range of existing bunting, then design and make my own using techniques such as sewing, stapling and gluing. Finally, I will evaluate my product.

**RE** – I am going to be learning about how people talk about God including Christians, Jews and Hindus.
