

Collective Worship at Home

A guide for parents with children isolating

Just because your child is at home does not mean they cannot take part in a short act of collective worship each day! Collective worship allows your child (and you) to come together for a special time during their day learning at home. It allows you to celebrate, reflect and share a calm time together.

Below is a two week cycle if your child has to isolate for 2 weeks from school, there is also an additional 2 weeks for extended periods of isolation.

This collective worship explores more about satisfaction using a glass of milk. What will happen to the milk as Rev Dave drinks it!? We learn from the Bible as Jesus meets a woman at a well collecting water.
