Facts I will be learning about:

English – lots of writing in terms of adventure stories, diaries, newspapers and poetry.

Maths – place value, addition, subtraction in 1000s and multiplication and division into 100s.

History – Romans laws, Anglo Saxon laws, Tudor punishments, Victorian goals.

Science – forces in action such as gravity and friction. Mechanisms and movement / energy types.

RE – What is the Bible to Christians? Where did it come from? What does it teach Christians today? What is the difference between the Bible and Qur'an? What is similar?

Home Learning Activities:

To help me prepare for my learning, at home I might:

English

Practice the Year 3 and 4 statutory spellings
Practice the Year 5 and 6 statutory spellings (*when confident with Year 3/4 spellings*)
Concentrate on between 8-12 words each week
Use a dictionary and write definitions for each of the words on the Crime and Punishment Vocabulary List
Write a book review of your favourite mystery/adventure story
Write a formal letter to Queen Victoria to stop public

Topic

Create a Crime and Punishment word search using vocabulary list
Make a fact file about the different torture methods throughout history in chronological order
Make a wanted poster for Dick Turpin
Create your own home-made finger print powder and make a record of your family's finger print impressions

Maths

Learn multiplication and division facts of all 12 times tables
Learn to tell the time to 1 minute intervals in analogue and digital time (12 and 24 hour)
Practice mental addition and subtraction relating to money, measure, time etc
Know the fraction, decimal and percentage equivalent of a quarter, half, three-quarters and a tenth
Learn the properties of common 3D shapes (eg: faces, edges and vertices)

Science

Make a list of simple activities, draw a diagram and label the forces eg *throwing a ball involves push, gravity and air resistance*. Use arrows to show the direction of each force.
List as many different materials as you can describe all of the properties for each one. Use vocabulary such as: translucent, absorbent, conductor
Using what you know about materials and air resistance, make the most effective parachute for a small toy figure
