- Our second beach school day will be on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> November. Please ensure children are wrapped up warmly in old clothes, with a waterproof coat and suitable footwear. All children will need to bring drinks and packed lunches. We will provide packed lunches for those children who ordered last time, Jo has the list. We will also use the same permission forms so PLEASE REMEMBER TO LET US KNOW IF THERE ARE ANY RECENT CHANGES.
- We have had lots of wandering uniform over the first half of this term. It's not unusual or unexpected but please check regularly and make sure you return any uniform that does not belong to your child as soon as you can please. Most things usually come back within a week or two. PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL UNIFORM IS

- <u>All children in Years 3, 4, 5 & 6</u> need trainers in school <u>every day</u> for Jazzy Jogging/Racy Running please. Every child who brings their trainers to school every day will have a fun outing to the park at the end of term. <u>Please ensure children wear school shoes and bring their trainers to change into (i.e. not wear trainers for the whole day. If they get wet they then have wet feet for the rest of the day!).

- Please order milk, toast and lunches no later than each Friday for the following week. School dinners are now £2.20 each, milk 75p/week and toast £1 per/week.
- Please note: we do not hold petty cash at school <u>we are not allowed to give</u> <u>change</u>. If you pay in cash please use the correct change, any balance will be credited to milk, toast, lunches or voluntary funds. If you pay by cheque please make it payable to 'The Unity Federation'. All payments should be handed in in a named envelope. Please help yourselves to envelopes near the entrance.
- Thank you for your help in starting each day promptly and encouraging the children to organise themselves in the mornings. <u>Please ensure everyone goes straight outside into the garden</u> as soon as they have hung up their bags. <u>Children DO NOT need to go in and out of classes for any reason. This is to ensure your children's safety</u>. All children from Y3 upwards are able to organise their own bookbags and reading, particularly Seahorses and Sea Turtles; Seashells need to change their books during the day to encourage their independence with Mrs Fulton's or my guidance.
- Please remember to drop off between 8.40-8.50am to minimise morning disruption and please pick up promptly at 3.15pm.
- Reminder of clubs for autumn. Clubs are £3 per session or £2.50 if paying for a full half term in advance. Please make cheques payable to 'Top Coaching'.
