Welcome Back!

- We have had a lovely start to the new school year. All of the children have moved into their new year groups and are settling in to their new routines beautifully. Reception children are really enjoying the mornings with their peers and are taking everything in their stride.
- Due to the difficulties we have experienced in the past with transporting small groups
 of children to Forest Schools, we have decided to run Beach Schools ourselves this
 year. We organised a bid for funding from the Ogden Trust who awarded us some
 funding for transport and costs. Beach schools will involve all the children going on 3
 full days of beach learning together throughout the year. More information to follow.
- <u>All children in Years 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6</u> will need trainers in school every day for Jazzy Jogging/Racy Running from next Monday 17th September please.
- Every child who brings their trainers to school every day will have a fun outing to the park at the end of term.
- Please note: we do not hold petty cash at school. Our finance policy states that we
 have to bank all money as it is received and we are not allowed to give change. If you
 pay in cash please use the correct change, any balance will be credited to milk, toast,
 lunches or voluntary funds. If you pay by cheque please make it payable to 'The Unity
 Federation'.
- Please order milk, toast and lunches no later than each Friday for the following week.
 If you wish to have the same lunches regularly let Jo know, thank you. School dinners are now £2.20 each, milk 75p/week and toast £1 per/week. We only accept payment and orders for a full week of milk and toast. All 2 day weeks will be free milk and toast for those who have it regularly to allow for any trips/days out.
- Children may bring in water to keep in the classrooms during the day and/or children are welcome to use the water fountain during the day. Squash drinks will be kept in the fridge until lunchtimes.





- Thank you for your help in starting each day promptly and encouraging the children to organise themselves in the mornings. Please ensure everyone goes straight outside into the garden as soon as they have hung up their bags. Children DO NOT need to go in and out of classes for any reason. This is to ensure your children's safety. All children from Y3 upwards are able to organise their own bookbags and reading, particularly Seahorses and Sea Turtles; Seashells need to change their books during the day to encourage their independence with Mrs Fulton's or my guidance.
- Please remember to drop off between 8.40-8.50am to minimise morning disruption and please pick up promptly at 3.15pm.
- Reminder of clubs for autumn. Clubs are £3 per session or £2.50 if paying for a full half term in advance. Please make cheques payable to 'Top Coaching'.
