#### <u>Uniform</u>

At Sculthorpe Church of England Primary Academy we require all students to wear a school uniform. Our school uniform helps our pupils to feel part of our school community and has been chosen to be comfortable and appropriate for the activities pupils will undertake during the school day. We are promoting positive behaviours and attitudes in school at the moment, uniform is an important part of this. We would value your support as parents in promoting this with your children at home and ensuring that they are correctly dressed for school at all time.

School Uniform - dark trousers, skirt etc with white polo shirt, royal blue jumper or cardigan.

PE - Monday - children to come in school in their PE kit. This will consist of dark tracksuit bottoms, leggings or shorts. We would like children to wear a coloured t-shirt for their house team to encourage a sense of belonging. We will let you know which colour house team if you don't know. These don't need to be with a logo they can just simply be from a supermarket.

Forest School - Wednesday (we will let you know when this affects your class) - dark clothing to be worn with a minimum amount of pattern/logo etc. Warm clothing, a coat and welly boots!

#### Morning Break Snack

We are promoting healthy eating at school and to help with this, the children in Fireflies and Dragonflies Classes can bring a piece of fruit or vegetable for them to eat during morning break time. Please can these be the only snacks brought to school for morning break time, if they have a packed lunch then other snacks can be provided for lunch.
