Dear Parents,

I am writing to you to let you know the plans that are in place for transition and reporting this year; please be aware that transition will be dependent on Government guidance for 21st June onwards, so the below information is provisional.

Transition

Year 6 into Year 7

I have been informed that, government guidelines allowing:

- Alderman Peel High School will be having their transition sessions on Wednesday 30th June, Thursday 1st July and Friday 2nd July.
- Fakenham Academy will be having their transition days on Wednesday 14th July, Thursday 15th July and Friday 16th July.
- You should have heard from your child's High School giving you this information, if you haven't then please contact them directly.

New Reception Intake

These children have been invited to visit the school for the mornings of Wednesday 14th to Friday 16th June.

Year 1 into Year 2

All Year 1 will be moving up to Barn Owl Class as Year 2 in September. They will be having their taster transition sessions on Wednesday 14th July to Friday 16th July. This will allow the children to get to know their new teachers as well as renew friendships formed previously.

Year 3 into Year 4 and Year 4 into Year 5

Due to the number of Year 1 into Year 2 children in September, all Year 3 children will be moving up to Tawny Owl Class as Year 4 in September and Year 4 into Year 5. They will be having their taster transition sessions on Wednesday 14th July to Friday 16th July. This will allow the children to get to know their new teachers as well as renew friendships formed previously.



Reports

I have discussed reports with Mr Allen and this year you will be offered a phone call after half term to discuss any questions or concerns you have with your child's teacher and for us to discuss how your child is in school. This will be a 10 minute phone call, as was in the Autumn Term.

At the end of the Summer Term you will get a written report, like in previous years, however we will not be reporting on attainment and progress due to the interruptions of the last 18 months. We will be reporting on how your child is doing, what they are good at, what they need to develop next year and on their wellbeing in school.

Please know that even though you are unable to come into school, if you have any concerns then please ring the office and make a time for your child's teacher to ring you back or alternatively you can email them (during school hours) on the email that was given during school closures.

June 21st 2021 – What will happen?

We are currently talking about what will happen to school times, bubbles and lots of other things from 21st June, however we will have to wait until the government give us guidance before any decisions can be made. Please bear with us, we will let you know as soon as we possibly can.
