Dear Parents,

I am writing to let you know of the changes that are going to have to happen, related to transition and end of year activities.

Year 6

Yesterday we were contacted by Fakenham Academy to inform us that their 3 transition days for the Y6 have been cancelled. They will be in contact with you to give you information about the Summer School they are hoping to run WB 26th July for Y6 children.

Today, I have been told that Alderman Peel High School will also not be running their 3 transition visits for the Y6 children. They are in the process of making alternative provision for this, possibly at the start of the new school year.

Year 6 Leavers Assembly will be held outside so all the classes can be together, as we do now for Collective Worship. However, sadly parents will not be able to attend. We are going to video the assembly and then either try to get it onto a disc or share it on the google drive, as we did for Christmas.

Year 6 will still have their Leaver's meal but this will be held in their own classroom with their class and not the whole school as normal.

Mr Parker has organised a Y6 trip to Hautbois, an outdoor activity centre, on Thursday 8th July. A letter and permission slip will follow with more information. A BIG thank you goes to the 'Friends of Sculthorpe' for paying for this trip as the children have not been able to fundraise themselves due to COVID and bubbles.

New Reception

The new parent meeting will now be held via zoom/teams on the Monday 12th July at 2pm. Transition visits to school have had to be cancelled as all the new reception come from different pre-schools. Parents will be offered a slot after school WB 12th July and WB 19th July that allows them to visit the school with their child, to look round, visit their classroom and meet the staff. If you have a child who will be starting with us in September please contact the office and we can make an appointment.

Move up days

Sadly, due to bubbles having to continue this will not happen as it has in the past. We understand that the children need to spend time with their new teacher before September, so we have looked at what we can do at the same time as keeping everyone as safe as possible. The guidance and Risk Assessment allows movement between classes by teachers. So the plan is on Thursday 15th July teachers will move round allowing them to spend a morning with the children they will have next year. Tawny Owl Class will have a morning of creative activities led by Mrs Brown and Y2 will have a morning of creative outdoor activities led by Mrs Robson-Parker.





The teachers moving round will have had a LFT on the Wednesday and will wear their visors and continue to follow our RA.

Sports Day

This year thwe will not be having a Sports Day as a whole school, but we are hoping to have a 'Sport Day' like PE session for each class before the end of the term. Photos will be posted in each classes facebook group once it has taken place.

Again, due to bubbles our whole school end of year trip will not be able to happen. So the decision has been made that each class will have an afternoon at the park for a picnic and play. Depending on the year group depends on the activities that they will do, however we need your permission to allow the children onto the play equipment.
