

Using an X Box, Play Station or a SMART TV to access the Oak National Academy Website

An alternative method of accessing your remote learning during times of isolation or lockdown.

X Box

1. Press the Xbox button to access the Home screen
2. Scroll to find **Microsoft Edge** and open by tapping the **A** button on your Xbox controller
3. Type in: **www.thenational.academy** into the address bar at the top of the screen
(To enter a URL/web address: Navigate to the address bar at the top of the screen and tap the **A** button. The on-screen keyboard will now appear, prompting you to enter a web address. Once complete, press the **A** button on the controller to load the corresponding page.)



Play Station

1. From the home page, navigate to the content area for games, applications and other services
2. Scroll until the **Internet Browser** option is highlighted with a **www** icon, open the browser by tapping the **X** button on your PS4 controller.
(If you can't see the internet browser **www** icon, go to the library and it will be under Apps)
3. Type in: **www.thenational.academy** into the address bar at the top of the screen
(To enter a URL/web address: Navigate to the address bar at the top of the page, labelled **Enter URL**, and tap the **X** button. The on-screen keyboard will now appear, prompting you to enter a web address. Once complete, press the **R2** button on the controller to load the corresponding page.)



SMART TV

1. Click the **Home** button on the remote control
2. Scroll until the pre-installed **web browser** is highlighted, open the browser by tapping the **OK** button on the remote control
3. Type in: **www.thenational.academy** into the address bar at the top of the screen
(To enter a URL/web address: Navigate to the address bar at the top of the screen, labelled **Enter URL**, and click **OK** on your remote control. The on-screen keyboard will now appear, prompting you to enter a web address. Once complete, press the **OK** button on the remote control to load the corresponding page.)



Once you have accessed the Oak National Academy website

1. Click on: **Lessons**
2. Click on: **Subjects**
3. Click on: **Show Year groups**
4. Find the relevant year group and select
5. Find the relevant subject and select
6. Find and select the lesson your teacher has directed you to complete.
