Using an X Box, Play Station or a SMART TV to access the Oak National Academy Website

An alternative method of accessing your remote learning during times of isolation or lockdown.

X Box

- 1. Press the Xbox button to access the Home screen
- 2. Scroll to find Microsoft Edge and open by tapping the A button on your Xbox controller
- 3. Type in: www.thenational.academy into the address bar at the top of the screen (To enter a URL/web address: Navigate to the address bar at the top of the screen and tap the A button. The on-screen keyboard will now appear, prompting you to enter a web address. Once complete, press the A button on the controller to load the corresponding page.)

Play Station

- From the home page, navigate to the content area for games, applications and other services
- Scroll until the Internet Browser option is highlighted with a www icon, open the browser by tapping the X button on your PS4 controller.
 (If you cant see the internet browser www icon, go to the library and it will be under Apps)
- 3. Type in: www.thenational.academy into the address bar at the top of the screen (To enter a URL/web address: Navigate to the address bar at the top of the page, labelled Enter URL, and tap the X button. The on-screen keyboard will now appear, prompting you to enter a web address. Once complete, press the R2 button on the controller to load the corresponding page.)

SMART TV

- 1. Click the Home button on the remote control
- Scroll until the pre-installed web browser is highlighted, open the browser by tapping the OK button on the remote control
- 3. Type in: www.thenational.academy into the address bar at the top of the screen (To enter a URL/web address: Navigate to the address bar at the top of the screen, labelled Enter URL, and click OK on your remote control. The on-screen keyboard will now appear, prompting you to enter a web address. Once complete, press the OK button on the remote control to load the corresponding page.)

- 4. Find the relevent year group and select
- 5. Find the relevent subject and select
- 6. Find and select the lesson your teacher has directed you to complete.
