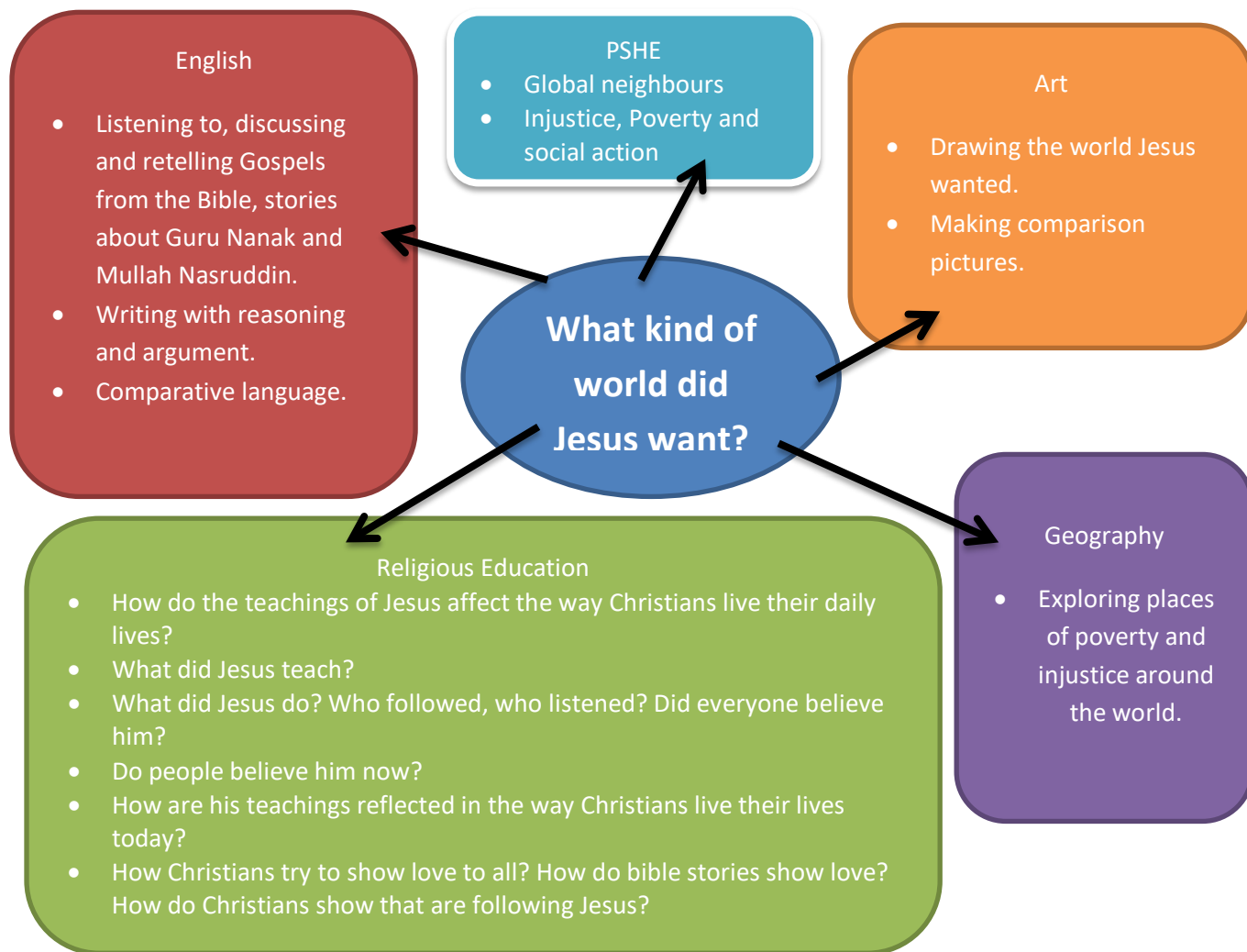


What kind of world did Jesus want?

Facts I will be learning about:

- I will be learning about what a gospel is? How it is telling of good news in Christianity. How it is found in the Bible and is about the teachings and life of Jesus. How Christians use the gospels in the New testament to try and live their lives like Jesus so they have a deeper relationship and connection with God.
- I will be learning about three gospels / teaching of Jesus: 1) The Good Samaritan, 2) The Calling of the First disciples and 3) Jesus Heals a Leper. I will be learning what messages these gospels give to Christians and how they live their lives differently because of them.
- I will be looking at how Christians live their daily lives and how this compares to leaders of Christianity as well as to what Jesus said in the Bible. I will use these ideas to try and make better some bad situations I have shown, such as someone being bullied, someone being homeless and someone not forgiving another person.
- I will look at the work of Christian Aid as a Christian charity around the world and the work it has done to remove poverty. I will look at how this reflects the Christian view of the world. I will try to answer the question are all Christians good neighbours?
- I will also learn about other world religions and the stories they use to teach their followers how to live. These will include Guru Nanak (Sikhism) and the boulder and Mullah Nassruddin (Islam) and the cloth vendor. I will compare these to the story of Jesus heals a leper.
